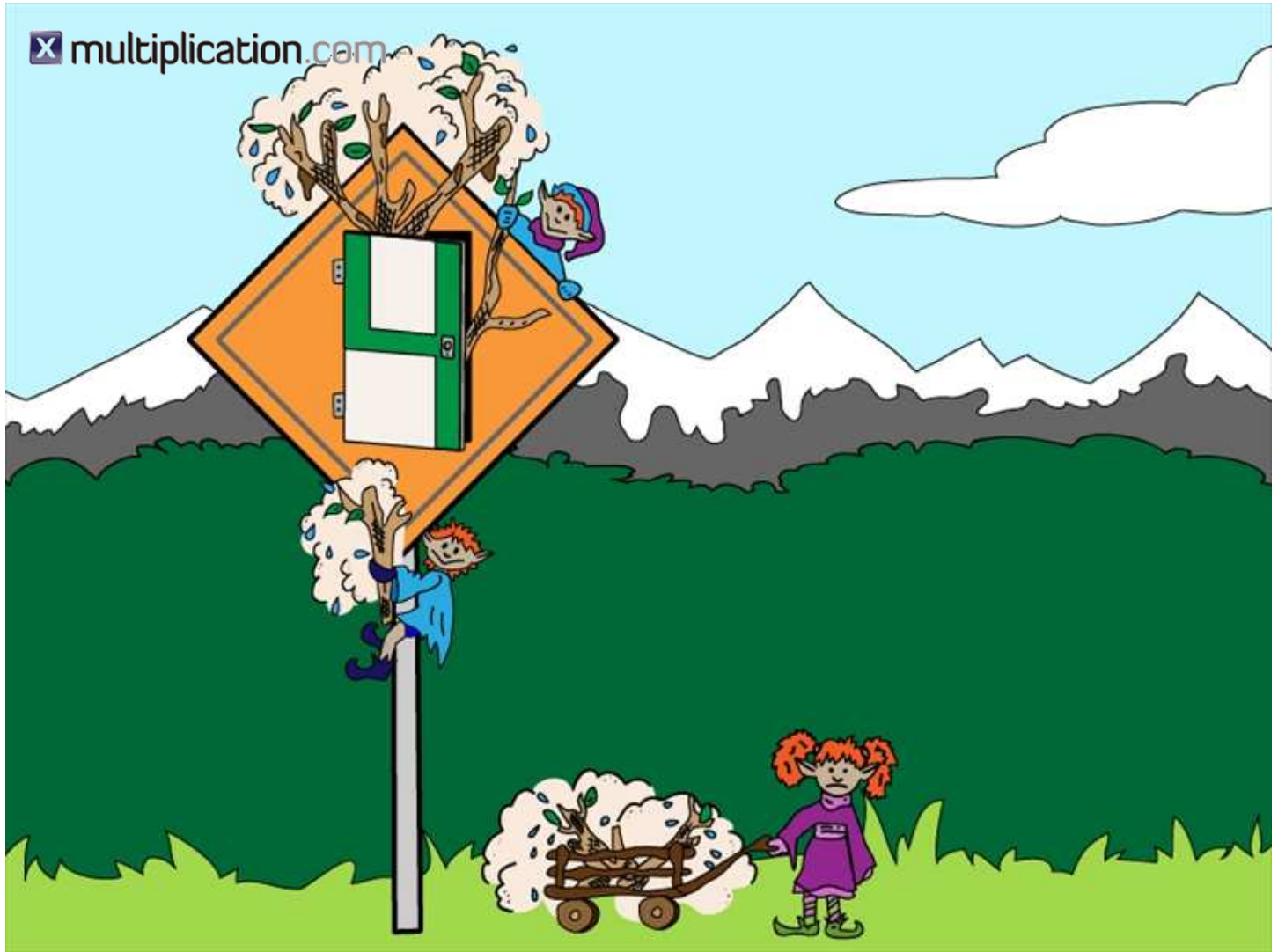

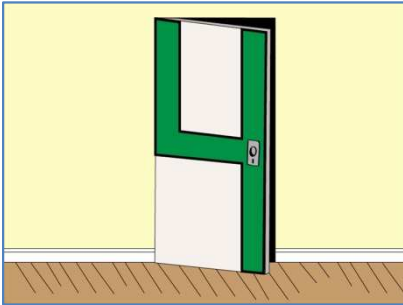


**Door x Sign =
Dirty Sticks**

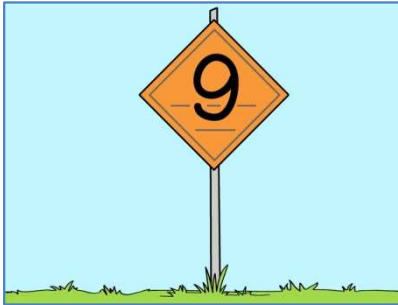
$$4 \text{ (Door)} \times 9 \text{ (Sign)} = 36 \text{ (Dirty Sticks)}$$

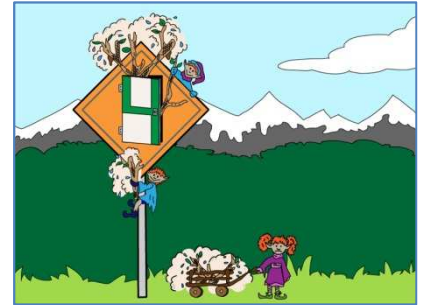
